# Overview of FY 2024 HUD CoC NOFA

- **What is the NOFO?**
  - Funding opportunity released by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to support Continuum of Care Programs.
- **Funding Priorities:**
  - Emphasis on permanent housing, ending homelessness, and coordinated entry.
  - Focus on equity, innovative housing solutions, and system performance improvements.
- **Eligibility**
  - Continuum of Care programs, including renewal and new projects.

# Key Changes & Updates



INTRODUCTION OF A 2-YEAR NOFO PROCESS: COMBINES  
FY 2024 AND FY2025

TIERING ADJUSTMENTS: TIER 1 IS SET TO 90% OF THE  
COC'S ANNUAL RENEWAL DEMAND (ARD)

FUNDING FOR SPECIFIC SUBPOPULATIONS MUST BE  
REALLOCATED WITH THE SAME FOCUS

EXPANSION OF REALLOCATION TERMS TO INCLUDE DV  
REALLOCATION AND YHDP REPLACEMENT

# FY 2024 Funding

## Eligible Project Types:

- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
- Joint Transitional Housing – Rapid Rehousing (Joint TH-RRH)

## New and Expansion Project Funding

- DV Bonus
- PSH Bonus

## Funding Available

- Tier 1: \$763,214 (90% of ARD)
- CoC Bonus: \$135,873
- DV Bonus: \$169,841
- CoC Planning: \$56,614 (not ranked)

# Local Competition Process



## Performance Metrics

Objective

Utilizes data from HMIS and APR

Projects are scored performance

- Utilization
- Spend Rate
- Exits to Permanency



## Supplemental

Subjective

Project details

Should inform scorer on program operations that cannot be seen in the Data

Each agency will receive a performance score card to inform a response in the supplemental

# Application Scoring Criteria

## 1. Performance Metrics

- 100 Pts
- Based on Performance Metrics that influence our System Performance Metrics
- Purely Objective

## 2. Supplemental

- 100 Pts
- Based on Narrative Response to program operations
- In this application have the opportunity to earn points back toward Performance Metrics
- Must be submitted online via Google Form

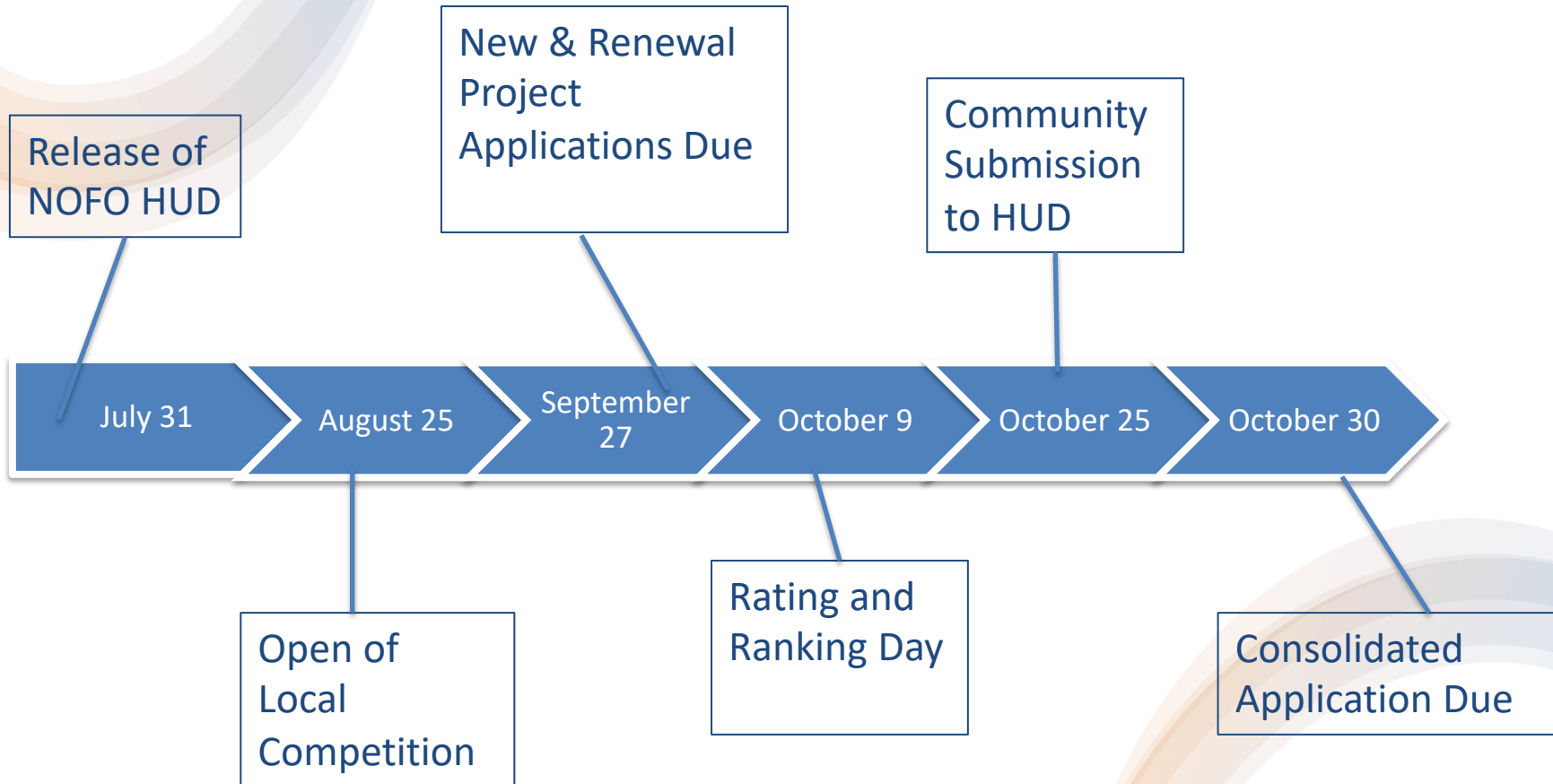
## 3. Rating and Ranking

- Renewal Projects (with the exception of CE and HMIS) will receive an average score for initial rankings
- Rating and Ranking Committee will meet to discuss how well projects meet the needs of the CoC for final rankings

# Appeals

- Must be submitted within 3 business days of notification of rating and ranking
- Send an email to [rncoc@wingedwolf.org](mailto:rncoc@wingedwolf.org)
  - Detail grounds for appeal
  - Supporting documentation
- May appeal on the grounds of:
  - Procedural Error
  - Incorrect Application of Criteria
  - New Information
